

AHES rising star award 2022

This award is bestowed by the AHES Executive Committee¹ to “rising stars” in health economics research. A “rising star” is a person whose work is beginning to make a significant impact nationally and internationally, reflecting either scientific excellence or policy impact (or both). The award process will be overseen and chaired by the AHES Vice President.²

Criteria for the Award: The nominee will be a current AHES member. The award is evaluated using NHMRC category descriptors for track record and is based on publications, grants, and impact (two pager). It is expected that the nominee is at least 2 years and less than 10 years (at the commencement date of the AHES Conference) from the date of the letter advising that their doctoral thesis was passed, unless career disruptions exist.

Details of the Award: The award includes a certificate and gift voucher of \$750. The awardee will be featured on the AHES website.

Obligations: The successful applicant is required to attend and present at the 43rd Annual AHES Conference in Brisbane where the award will also be presented.
